That's why my place at RMIT is called a Commonwealth -supported place (CSP).

That's why my place at RMIT is called an Australian fee-paying place (AFP).

Not every postgrad course has CSP access. You can find a list of those that do below.

If you get a CSP place like me, you'll be paying between about \$6000 and \$10,500 a year, depending on what you're studying.





I'm doing a masters course that costs around \$24,000 a year but costs depend on what you study, from around \$11,000 to \$32,000 or so. You can check the fees here.

I didn't want to pay this straight away, so I got a HECS-HELP loan from the Australian Government that means I'm not paying anything upfront to study.



I couldn't afford to pay straight away so I got a FEE-HELP loan from the Australian Government - that means I'm not paying anything upfront to study.

I got the loan as an Australian citizen. But you can apply for one if you hold an Australian permanent humanitarian visa or, in some cases, if you're an New Zealand citizen. Other New Zealand citizens, or holders of permanent Australian (non-humanitarian) visas, can get a CSP place but have to pay their contribution upfront.



I got the loan as an Australian citizen. But you can apply for one if you hold an Australian permanent humanitarian visa or, in some cases, if you're an New Zealand citizen, or if you're a permanent visa holder undertaking bridging study.
