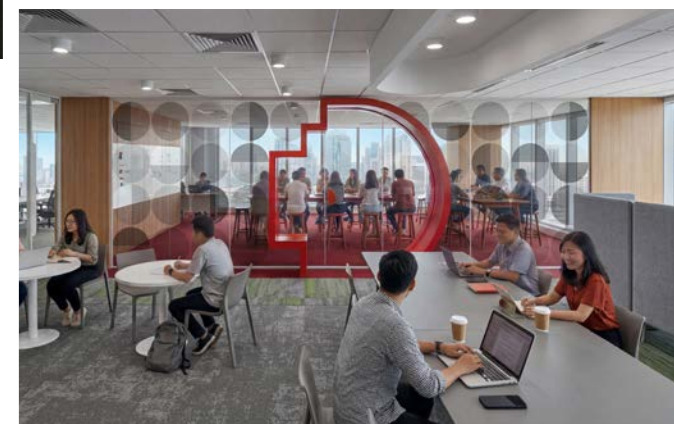
RMIT Southeast Asia Hub

The new RMIT Southeast Asia Hub is a space to connect, learn and grow, acting as a front door for government, industry, students and alumni in the heart of Jakarta.

Located in a purpose-built space at the World Trade Centre 2 Jakarta, in the CBD, the Hub features flexible learning and meeting spaces for students and partners.

Bringing together our existing activities in Indonesia, the hub provides an opportunity for long-term growth to engage and collaborate on the development needs of the nation and its region.

Core activities span four pillars, directly aligned to the Golden Indonesia Vision 2045 strategy. We will partner with government and industry to design bespoke applied short courses – from cyber security to game design and project management – that meet the needs of the local community.

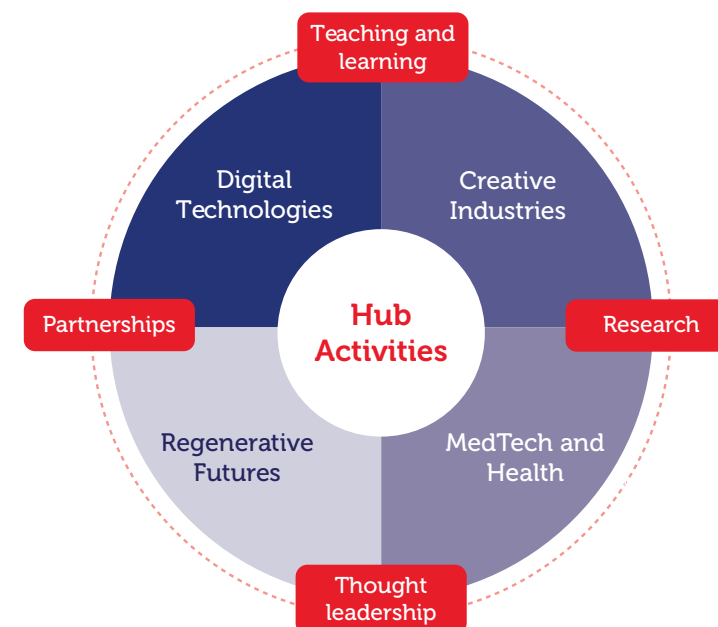

The new hub deepens our presence in Indonesia, where we have undertaken skills development, knowledge exchange, and research and innovation partnerships for almost two decades.

Our longstanding engagement with Southeast Asia is central to our international mission, delivering industry-connected education solutions and research partnerships across the region.

- **RMIT Vietnam:** Vietnam's first international university, delivering world-class education for more than 25 years, with more than 12,000 students, 1,300 staff, and nearly 25,500 alumni.
- **Asia Hub:** oversees key RMIT initiatives including The Australian APEC Study Centre, championing Australia's priorities and regional prosperity across the Asia Pacific, and the Australia Vietnam Policy Institute, the first of its kind bilateral policy institute driving the strategic and economic relationship between the nations.
- **Singapore Institute of Management partnership:** founded in 1987 and now celebrating 55,000 graduates across seven jointly delivered programs.
- **Infinite Learning at Nongsa Digital Park partnership:** supported by the Indonesian and Singapore governments to boost the region's games and interactivity workforce.
- **RMIT Hanoi Industry and Innovation Hub:** a gateway for strategic collaboration between the higher education sector, industry and government in Vietnam.
