Position Summary

Working as part of Architecture & Software Engineering, the Scrum Master’s primary purpose is to facilitate agile development squads in the successful delivery of RMIT’s Salesforce transformation project, with a focus on implementing Education Cloud.

You will lead 2–3 squads, supporting the Project Manager and collaborating closely with the Product Owner to ensure alignment with strategic priorities and delivery goals. This role is responsible for enabling squads to deliver high-quality, realistic outcomes for the business, maintaining a strong focus on continuous improvement, and meeting commitments made during quarterly planning.

The Scrum Master will work with business customers, product stream stakeholders, and project managers to manage responsibilities and remove impediments, ensuring transparency and clear communication on all squad-related matters. You will coach and elevate agile practices within the squads, fostering a culture of accountability, collaboration, and product-led delivery.

A key focus for this role is the Salesforce Education Cloud implementation and its integration with RMIT’s broader digital ecosystem, supporting essential university operations and student experiences globally.

This role may lead and work with 2–3 squads of up to 10 people each and may require leadership of cross-squad requirements within the Salesforce product stream.

Key Accountabilities

- Implement, guide, and maintain high standards of scrum/agile practices and guardrails within the team, including tracking success metrics against key measures.
- Educate and guide the organisation in Agile, Scaled Agile Framework, Design Thinking, and Lean practices.
- Facilitate various events designed to increase organisational capability and creative confidence (e.g., retrospectives, inception workshops, ideation, hack days).
- Facilitate sprint outcomes by listening to and making people aware of impediments, building momentum around new practices, and helping keep the team accountable for their deliverables.
- Take a common-sense approach to the application of different methodologies, while keeping true to the principles of deep discovery, iterative development, and validation.
- Communicate and work with key functional groups and stakeholders to help embed a consistent way of working across the value stream.
- Facilitate and implement quality user testing methodology, including sourcing customers and running interviews.
- Coach and mentor across teams with a view to increasing the organisation's creative confidence.
- Mentor and coach team members to upskill and drive learning and development.
- Maintain communication channels (e.g., walls, boards, and various story cards) and manage communications where required.
- Assist with prioritisation, lead backlog grooming and planning.
- Remove impediments as well as help teams remove impediments and blockers.
- Help manage and mitigate risk whilst exercising sound judgment.
- Collaborate closely with Product Owners and Project Managers to ensure alignment and successful delivery.
- Support cross-squad dependencies and alignment as needed.
- Assist with project reporting and governance requirements.

Key Selection Criteria

1. Proven experience in being resourceful and entrepreneurial in approach to problem solving.
2. Minimum 2 years' experience as a Scrum Master in a distributed hybrid squad setup.
3. Experience in an education setting for 1–2 years nice to have but not essential.
4. Experience working across a dynamic portfolio at various levels of scale.
5. Analytical and critical thinker with strong facilitation, situational awareness, conflict resolution, and continuous improvement skills.
6. Demonstrated experience in Agile implementation and applying relevant SAFe/Scrum/Agile principles, practices, and theories.
7. Certified Scrum Master (Scrum Alliance, Scrum.org, or equivalent) and proven agile project delivery experience.
8. Strong technical aptitude and experience leading teams in delivering quality software (Salesforce preferred).
9. Excellent interpersonal skills for building strong working relationships within agile squads, with peers, business stakeholders, and the broader IT community; ability to influence and coach others.

Qualifications

Diploma or Degree in relevant discipline and/or relevant experience is required who can bridge the business and technical domains by liaising with business, user and IT representatives

SAFe Agilist or Scrum Master certification

Agile Project Management Certification (or hands on Agile project management experience and working towards certification) preferred
