Position Summary

Working as part of Student Experience team, the Senior Functional Analyst will play a key role in enabling the University's strategic journey toward Education Cloud, supporting student and staff engagement through a unified Salesforce ecosystem.

You will be joining an established agile squad focused on Salesforce delivery, with the opportunity to help shape the team's ways of working while leveraging RMIT's existing Salesforce capability and knowledge. Operating within a fast-paced, lean agile environment, the Senior Functional Analyst will collaborate closely with a Senior Design and Technical Leads, Salesforce Developers, QA Engineers, and business stakeholders to define and deliver enhancements aligned with RMIT's roadmap for a 360° view of the student experience.

The role requires strong experience in functional analysis, stakeholder engagement, and agile delivery. You will be responsible for defining detailed requirements and acceptance criteria (Features and Stories), supporting development and testing activities, and ensuring that solutions meet business needs. As a senior member of the team, you will also lead initiatives, supervise task-based activities, and contribute to continuous improvement across the squad.

The Senior Functional Analyst will report regularly on assigned tasks and sub-projects and must be able to effectively engage and communicate with staff at all levels across the University, including external partners and vendors.

- Deliver high-quality functional services across the Salesforce platform within the Student Experience portfolio, supporting RMIT's transformation to Education Cloud. Ensure all solutions meet compliance, Enterprise Architecture standards, and business user requirements, with system and procedural documentation maintained to enable support functions.
- Document business requirements, user stories, and acceptance criteria to support agile delivery.
- Collaborate with the Scrum Master and business stakeholders to prioritise sprint activities and ensure alignment with strategic goals.
- Work closely with Salesforce Developers and Technical Leads to guide solution design and feature development, ensuring functional integrity and user value.
- Define UAT test conditions, cases, tools, and methods based on business requirements. Analyse
 and report test activities and results to the initiative lead, resolving issues and risks. Manage and
 quide testing activities to ensure usability and quality standards are met.
- Translate business requirements into functional designs within the SDLC, delivering solutions
 that meet agreed service levels, standards, and processes. Maintain current knowledge of
 system configuration and capabilities, applying this to deliver innovative and effective solution
 designs.
- Collect and analyse data to identify opportunities for system improvement and enhanced customer satisfaction. Collaborate with stakeholders and delivery partners to implement fixes or enhancements that fully address client needs and improve the effectiveness of RMIT's Salesforce ecosystem.
- Liaise with vendors to ensure service delivery meets agreed service levels and contributes to the overall success of the Salesforce transformation.

- 2. Agile delivery experience
- 3. Able to lead a significantly complex piece of analysis work
- 4. Exposure to education sector is highly advantageous but not essential
- 5. Elicitation experience required including senior stakeholder engagement
- 6. Attention to detail, yet able to step back and see the big picture when the situation requires

- 11. Flexible, ability to adapt to change quickly and able to work with ambiguity, prioritise

- 15. Sound knowledge of project management methodologies
