We are pleased to welcome RMIT alumna Jason Grapsas who has recently joined the Student Recruitment team, coming across from the RMIT International Recruitment Team.

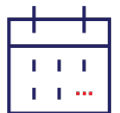
We are also excited to welcome Sara Sidhom (nee' Jaffer) who has also joined the team from William Angliss – Welcome Jason and Sara!

Accommodation Scholarships

If you have students thinking of relocating to Melbourne to study at RMIT, there are a range of accommodation options near campus. RMIT has endorsed 16 purpose-built student accommodation properties in and around Melbourne who offer new students a safe and welcoming place to call home while they transition to further study and life in a new city.



In 2022, Atira, dwell Village, Journal, Scape, UniLodge and Walert House will be offering accommodation scholarships to assist students relocating. These scholarships are awarded to students who are experiencing financial and educational disadvantage and are paid as a rental subsidy to reduce to their weekly contribution. With a scholarship, students can live close to campus from as little as \$77.50 per week (prices vary depending on property and in 2021 ranged from \$77.50 to \$245 per week). Applications for an accommodation scholarship close on 10 October 2021.
