## SECTION 5: Folio submission

**In order for your selection task to be considered, you must include a folio of work**

Your folio must comprise **5 or more completed graphic pieces**, including a selection of process or developmental work for each piece. It should demonstrate your design, problem solving and technical skills in:

- 2D and 3D design (“2D” can be any flat surface graphic, layout or illustration. “3D” can be packaging or digital)
- typography
- the use of graphic design industry software
- drawing
- use of different materials or mediums

Examples of work to consider are: illustrations, technical drawings, paintings or artwork, graphic designs, photography, models, packaging, video, and/or 2D/ 3D animation. It is recommended that your folio shows a variety of work (different skills, mediums or audience) rather than a folio of similar pieces.

Next to each completed piece, provide a short statement describing the task and the outcome (maximum 40 words each). This should explain the concept and how you used design to solve a problem. The explanation should include a brief justification of selected design elements (colour scheme, composition, typeface, etc).

### **Folio submission:**
