SECTION 5: Design exercise for first year entry applicants

You must complete a two (2) part design exercise which provides an opportunity to communicate your creative thinking through an image and written responses. You should draw on your own experience, imagination and skills in putting forward a thoughtful and creative response of your own. There is no one correct response that we are looking for and it is not expected that you have any substantial prior knowledge of interior design. In this task you are required to demonstrate a critical and considered understanding of your own work.

Part 1: Provide a piece of your own work (a single image) that demonstrates your creative abilities. You are free to use any medium, including drawing, illustration, model making or sculpture, photography, collages, painting - anything that you think will express your creativity.

The image must be formatted as JPEG or PDF and must be no larger than 3MB or you may provide a URL to your single image if hosted online.

Part 2: In no more than 300 words, discuss the thinking behind the creative piece you selected in Part 1 including the reasons why you selected it.

If you are applying for advanced standing, please complete section 6 only.

SECTION 6: Folio requirements for advanced standing applicants

If you have successfully completed at least one full year of tertiary study in architecture, interior design, industrial design, landscape, architecture, art, fashion design, spatial design, visual communication or media, you must complete this section of the selection task.

You must supply evidence of your creative thinking in the form of a folio that contains a variety of your personal work. The folio should demonstrate your creative thinking and/or your particular interests in interior design. It should evidence your conceptual, design, problem solving and technical skills and include evidence of how ideas were developed and decisions were made in relation to finished works.

Examples of work to include in your folio are drawings, maps, paintings, graphic designs, photographs, digital images, models, sculpture, video, scripting, short stories, and/or 2D and 3D Flash animation.

Submissions instructions:

- Upload your folio as a single PDF document (maximum of 10 pages). The file must be no larger than 5MB.

- Supply a URL to your folio. Provide the username or password if applicable.
