1. What is your interest in interior design? (maximum 150 words).

2. Provide details of your experience such as employment, voluntary work, etc., or a description of what you have done, over what periods and how it strengthens your application to this program (maximum 150 words).

If you are applying for first year entry, please complete section 5 only.

Section 5: Folio requirements for first year entry applicants

You must supply evidence of your creativity in the form of a folio containing a variety of your own creative or visual work. The folio should demonstrate your design or artistic interests and creative thinking and show a range of communication and technical skills. Please include a broad range of creative or visual works including art, design or media. You are not required to submit work specifically related to interior design. You should include evidence of how ideas were developed as well as finished works.

Examples of work to include in your folio are hand drawings, paintings, graphic designs, photographs, digital images, models, sculpture, video, scripting, short stories, websites, and/or 2D and 3D Flash animation.

Your folio should use a clear and simple graphic layout, include titles and short descriptions of your work.

Submission instructions

- Upload your folio as a single PDF document (maximum of 10 pages). Movies and other digital media can be shared via a working URL or MPEG, MOV or AVI file. The file must be no larger than 10MB.

- Provide a URL to your folio if hosted online (please provide the username and password if applicable).

If you are applying for advanced standing, please complete section 6 only.

Section 6: Folio requirements for advanced standing applicants

If you have successfully completed at least one full year of tertiary study in architecture, interior design, industrial design, landscape, architecture, art, fashion design, spatial design, visual communication or media, you must complete this section of the selection task.

You must supply evidence of your creative thinking in the form of a folio that contains a variety of your personal work. The folio should demonstrate your creative thinking and/or your particular interests in interior design. It should evidence your conceptual, design, problem solving and technical skills and include evidence of how ideas were developed and decisions were made in relation to finished works.

Examples of work to include in your folio are drawings, maps, paintings, graphic designs, photographs, digital images, models, sculpture, video, scripting, short stories, and/or 2D and 3D Flash animation.

Submission instructions

- Upload your folio as a single PDF document (maximum of 10 pages). The file must be no larger than 5MB.

- Provide a URL to your folio if hosted online (please provide the username and password if applicable).
