


Program Highlights

22 startups accepted from 80+ applications into 2 cohorts. In alignment with our commitment to diversity and inclusion 50% of selected startups are led/co-led by female founders, highlighting Activator's role in fostering inclusive entrepreneurship.

With a total of A\$283,000 in funding disbursed by year's end, the Activator Capital Fund (ACF) provided critical financial support to fuel the growth of high-potential startups. Program participants also get access to other RMIT resources such as Library, Makerspace and Co-working space at Building 98.

With guidance from 10 experienced coaches and 6 ACF Board members, LaunchHUB startups benefit from tailored mentorship and strategic insights.

We have run 72 total sessions for two of the latest cohorts that includes Workshop, Check-in, Coaching and Presentation sessions. This number also includes the program's rigorous selection process involves a 2-day Bootcamp to shortlist up to 12 successful startups per cohort.

Pitch Night Highlights

This year, we hosted two exciting LaunchHUB Pitch Night events, where the startups from our cohorts took centre stage to showcase their journeys and innovations. These nights allowed entrepreneurs to pitch their businesses to a live audience and a distinguished judging panel, competing for recognition and awards.

But the stakes were even higher—out of these 21 startups, 14 successfully secured grants from the Activator Capital Fund, collectively receiving a pool of \$260,000 to scale their impact and address some of the world's most pressing challenges. This achievement highlights the growing influence of our program, which provides startups with the mentorship, resources, and financial support needed to accelerate their progress. The energy was electric, and the talent on display was nothing short of inspiring. Below are some memorable moments from these unforgettable nights.

VentureHUB is designed for startups who are ready to go the distance. It explores scalable impact strategies that drive profitability and viability.




Program Highlights

Startups who successfully applied to the program are all given the opportunity to pitch for the Jacques Nasser Philanthropic Fund. The fund is worth A\$75,000.00 in total each year, and each startup may be granted for up to A\$15,000.00 once.

This year, Activator successfully disbursed the full allocation - 7 startups participated in the program with 5 of them successfully secured the full funding amount of A\$15,000.00 each.

Since launching in 2021, Kaboose has earned recognition as a finalist in several prestigious programs, including the iAwards, RMIT Activator LaunchHUB & VentureHUB Program, iAwards Victorian Finalist, Startup Vic x One Roof: HerStartup Pitch Night and JITO Australia Pitch Competition. Kaboose also reached a significant milestone in December 2024, in being awarded a significant 2-year grant from the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

Residency

Residency is a loosely structured program offered exclusively to select alumni to access resources in support of their entrepreneurial endeavours.

Program Highlights

The Residency program offers multiple touchpoints throughout the year, fostering a supportive environment and ensuring accountability to maintain motivation. Participants gain access to a variety of RMIT resources, including the Library, Makerspace, and co-working spaces in Buildings 97 and 98. Active startups are encouraged to extend their participation as needed.

As part of the Residency, startups engage in regular Group Check-in sessions with an Activator staff member. During these sessions, they share updates, celebrate successes, and discuss challenges, receiving valuable peer feedback and staff advice. The program also provides on-demand mentoring from a roster of experts, and monthly gatherings known as HUBDays feature guest speakers on relevant themes.

Notably, program alumni and residents such as GetMee, Huddled, Evitat, Project Flock, and Equioa have successfully secured investments, acquired customers, and increased sales. Additionally, alumni Esper Satellite Imagery and Lurra Systems have collaborated on joint tenders, leveraging their technologies to expand sales in emerging markets.

Program Highlights

This year, we won a \$400K, 3-year grant from LaunchVic to run a series of Circular Tech startup programs. Partnering with local consultancies Anvarta, Lifecycles, and Boomerang Labs, the [Re]Launch Circular Tech startup programs were developed to drive circular economy tech innovations.

The project's launch event was held on September 19th. With a panel session to open the event, the panelists conversed on the future of circular tech in Victoria. It drew 140 attendees from various background including, but not limited to, government, industry and the Victorian circular community members.

The project consists of 4 programs to be delivered. The first and only one for this year is the Incubator program. The first Pre-accelerator program will run on the first half of 2025, followed by another iteration of the Incubator. The second Pre-accelerator program will be delivered in 2026.

Global Growth

The Global Growth project aims to empower businesses to expand globally by enhancing competencies, ensuring sustainable growth and overcoming barriers to international market.

Ready-to-Export Women-led MSMEs Short Course

Powered by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, and in collaboration with the Australian APEC Study Centre, we delivered the Australia Awards in Indonesia: Women-led Medium, Small, Micro Enterprises – Ready to Export Short Course.

The program focused on three goals: promoting public-private cooperation for market access, providing capacity-building through networking, mentoring, and digital skills training, and exchanging best practices to enhance women's participation in markets.

The application process attracted 318 applicants and only 25 businesses accepted. The program did incredibly with 100% satisfaction rate









APEC Women's Business

Powered by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, and in collaboration with the Australian APEC Study Centre, this program focuses on empowering women-led businesses to expand locally and globally by enhancing business competencies and overcoming barriers related to gender and social inequalities.

The program attracted 206 applications and only 19 businesses were accepted from 9 APEC economies including Indonesia, Malaysia, and Mexico, participated in the program. The program has been recognised in the 2024 G20's compendium of best practices for increasing women's participation in international trade. Read more <u>here</u>.







Founder Academy

The Founder Academy is an ideation platform where like-minded individuals collaborate in multidisciplinary groups to understand problem spaces and generate innovative ideas.

Innovation Program

Funded by RMIT UP for the first cohort in 2023 and the second one this year, this program is an initiative designed for staff seeking to drive innovation within the organisation.

Through structured innovation activities, the program enhanced internal capabilities, generating over 200 new ideas, with 20 concepts validated and 6 prototypes developed. Participants reported increased confidence and capability in applying innovation in their work and beyond.

By the end of the program, 85% of participants agreed that this program helped them to be more confident to work on an innovative idea and understand the ways of building a strong foundation.




