- 2. List preferred Host Insitution courses on your study plan next to the RMIT course equivalents, then read the **Student Approval** section
  - ♦ Please contact the **RMIT Global Learning** if you require additional course information from the host institution
- 3. Attach and submit your study plan and Host Institution course guides to an RMIT Student Connect enquiry (Select Global Learning Programs > Submit a study plan). This will be reviewed by your RMIT Academic School/College
- 4. When the signed and approved study plan is returned to you, please upload it to your Mobi application
- 5. If applying for 2 semesters, you must complete one Study Plan per semester
