Why should I apply for a scholarship?

Scholarships can help pay for a range of different costs associated with study. Relocating from a regional area, textbooks, program materials, and course fees are all expenses that students might incur when they commence their studies. A scholarship can help cover these costs, giving you more time to focus on your education.

What type of scholarships are available?

Some scholarships are available to those enrolled in specific programs to encourage Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to enter professions where they are under-represented. Other scholarships assist those experiencing financial disadvantage, alleviating some of the barriers that might prevent them from completing their education. Students who live in rural or regional areas might need help with relocation expenses and can apply for an accommodation scholarship. There are also scholarships for those considering a pathway through Vocational Education programs, or for postgraduate students continuing their studies.

Am I eligible for a scholarship?

Most students will be eligible for the Gama-dji Orientation and RMIT Indigenous Study Support scholarships. The eligibility criteria for all scholarship can be found via the website, along with the application closing dates, value and duration.
