
POSITION TITLE: Sports Media**Position Outline:**

As a member of the Sport Media Team, you will be responsible to capture and provide media content on the RMIT Redbacks team at the UniSport Nationals events. This will be through a range of media channels including photography, videography, or journalism.

Content captured will be used for Social Media, RMIT website and any other relevant marketing collateral.

There are positions available for media team members for the following events:

- **Div 1 & 2 Nationals: 26 Sept – 2 October, 2021 – Gold Coast QLD**

Remuneration:

The role of the Media team members is a volunteer position. However, team members will be compensated by a fully subsidised event. This includes:

- RMIT Package (accommodation, uniform, team dinners)
- Flights to and from the Gold Coast

Not included: UniSport Registration fee (approximately \$20), transport at the event.

Reporting Line:

RMIT Sport Communications Advisor

University Team Manager (UTM) – RMIT Representative Sport Officer

Preferred Requirements:

Studying towards: Photography, Media, Communications or Advertising.

Roles & Responsibilities:

(Example for photographer – other positions will have similar requirements)

Prior to the Event:

1. Meet with the Communications Advisor & UTM to clarify role, discuss event brief and gain greater awareness of the event
2. Organise photography equipment, AV loans available at RMIT if required
3. You may also be required to attend some sport team training sessions

During the Event:

1. Follow direction from Communications Advisor & UTM to shoot as many sports as possible. General requirements include a good mix of landscape and portrait shots, action shots, team photos, a mix of close up and distance shots and crowd/audience interactions
2. Allow time each afternoon to edit and delete unwanted photos/footage
3. Provide top 5 photos from the day to the UTM each evening
4. Attend team events, including team dinners
5. It is expected that all media staff be well rested and alert to undertake their duties to the best of their ability. Should this not occur, media staff will be dismissed and sent home

After the Event:

1. Within 2 weeks of the completion of the event - provide all remaining images/videos to the Communications Advisor & UTM
2. All raw content should be provided to RMIT Sport
3. Provide suggestions to assist the UTM to run a more efficient and effective media team at Nationals
