**POSITION TITLE: Sports Trainer and Therapist****Position Outline:**

The Sports Trainer and Therapist team will accompany the representative sport teams at the Nationals Div 1 & Div 2 event 26 Sept – 2 October, 2021 – Gold Coast QLD. They will be responsible for providing first aid and injury treatment to team members. The role will comprise of:

- Basic muscular and skeletal treatment
- Remedial Massage
- Immediate First Aid treatment
- Sports Training

\*\* Successful applicants will only be expected to do what they are comfortable with and have been suitably trained for.

This team will comprise of 8-10 team members (as required). Sports Trainer and Therapist team members will be assigned to a sports teams, whom they will remain with for the duration of the event.

**Remuneration:**

The role of the Sports Trainer and Therapist staff is a volunteer position. However, team members will be compensated by a fully subsidised event. This includes:

- RMIT Package (accommodation, uniform, team dinners)
- Flights to and from the Gold Coast

Not included: UniSport Registration fee (approximately \$20), transport at the event.

**Essential Requirements:**

Level 2 First Aid

**Preferred Requirements:**

Studying towards: Osteopathy, Chiropractic, Physiotherapy, Massage, Myotherapy  
Sports Trainer Qualifications and Experience

**Roles & Responsibilities:**Prior to the Event:

1. Meet with the UTM to clarify role and gain awareness of the event.
2. Make recommendations for first aid supplies and ensure the first aid kits are well stocked.
3. Attend a minimum 2 sport team training sessions with assigned team.

During the Event:

1. Accompany their sport team to all sporting/competition venues. You will remain with this team for all scheduled games.
2. You may be required to assist with other sport teams, as directed by the UTM.
3. Provide therapy treatments back at the hotel for team members as required.

General role includes:

- Sports Trainer – This will involve immediate first aid treatment, strapping, injury prevention and courtside treatments, as well as assistance with warm-ups and cool downs as required. Sports trainer may also be required to act as water runner or boundary umpire (sport dependent).
- Therapist – The role will involve treating team members back at the hotel. This may include massage, injury treatment, and referral for further treatment or diagnosis.

\* Hours of work will vary depending on competition schedule, and team members need for pre / post treatment.

\* It is expected that all Sports Trainer and Therapist staff be well rested and alert to undertake their duties to the best of their ability. Should this not occur, Sports Trainers may be dismissed and sent home.

Post event:

1. Provide suggestions to assist the UTM to run a more efficient and effective medical support operation to assist athletes at the event.
2. Return any first aid supplies to UTM.
