

Course Experience Survey (CES)



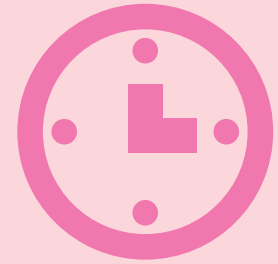
Purpose

To give students the opportunity to provide feedback on their courses and help improve the quality of the learning experience for future cohorts.



Privacy

All survey answers are confidential. However, students are expected to observe the values of RMIT when writing their answers, as reflected in relevant university regulations and policies. Formal actions can be taken when students behave in a manner that is considered inappropriate.



Timing

The survey link is emailed to students in the second half of each semester and surveys take approximately 10 minutes to complete per course.

Prize Draw

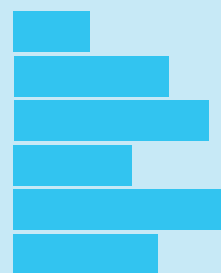
The CES includes an optional question for students who would like to go into the draw to either win an iPad or have a similar monetary contribution made toward the creation of a scholarship for future students.

At the close of the CES period, a winner is randomly selected from the pool of students who opted to go into the draw and they are awarded the prize they selected.



Questions

The questions are focused on the teaching quality and the course experience as a whole. The majority of the questions are multiple choice, with the answer scale ranging from 'Strongly Disagree' to 'Strongly Agree'.
