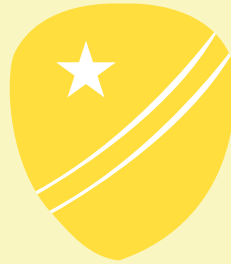


Graduate Outcome Survey (GOS)



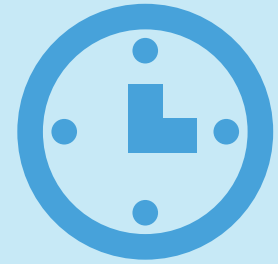
Purpose

To assess how well higher education (HE) students are being prepared for post-graduation success and to gauge graduates' overall program satisfaction.



Prize Draw

Students participating in the survey have the option to go into the draw to win one of twelve \$1000 Visa prepaid gift cards, or one of 60 runner-up Visa gift card prizes. The total prize pool is valued at \$32,000.



Timing

The survey is emailed to graduates approximately four months after they complete their qualification. Additionally, three years after completion, graduates are emailed the GOS-Longitudinal survey.

Government Mandate

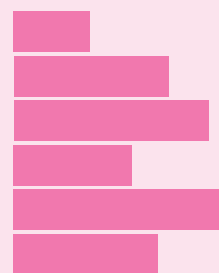

The GOS is funded by the Australian Government Department of Education and Training and is administered by the Social Research Centre (SRC).



Questions

The majority of the survey questions are multiple choice and span topics including graduates' post-study employment, further study undertaken and overall program satisfaction.
