Documents Required

English Language Proficiency

Students are required to RMIT's English Language requirements.

- Students can meet via:
- English Language Proficiency test
- English Language Provider
- A recognised qualification / English speaking countries

Document requirements

English Proficiency tests Explained

- IELTS Academic - Valid for two years for direct entry into an award program or 1 year into REW EAP studies.
- PTE tests - Valid for two years for direct entry into an award program or 1 year into REW EAP studies. We are required to validate this test online. To do so the student is required to send their score via the PTE portal to RMIT.
- REW QPT tests – is valid for 12 month into an REW EAP program. Can not be used for direct entry into an RMIT Program. For information on how to get access to conduct QPT tests please contact: agentmanagement@rmit.edu.au

Documents Required

Other Documents required – Gaps in studies

If there has been a gap in studies or intended gap in studies (more than 1 year if the student is overseas or more the 6 months if onshore) we require to know what the student has been doing. Please provide:

- ❖ C.V / resume – This should contain dates, position title, company / business name, and duties and responsibilities
- ❖ Employment letters – Should be on company letterhead, be dated, signed and have the name of the applicant
- ❖ Statement of purpose / statement of activities - be clear as to explain what the student has been doing or intends to do.
- ❖ Onshore students provide current enrolment

Documents Required

Integrity Checks

- ❖ Students from certain regions will be required to provide to complete the [SSVF form](#) as part of their application.
- ❖ Students are required to complete this form in their own words. **Do not complete this form on their behalf.**
- ❖ Please advise the student to answer honestly and disclose any past visa refusals to Australia or any other country.
- ❖ Certain regions are also required to provide Financial documentation and complete the SSVF [financial check](#).

Required Information

Pathways

- Please indicate on the students application if they are interested in a pathway, if they do not meet direct entry to their chosen program
- If you do not specify a VE pathway will be offered for Bachelor programs
- DP003 Diploma of Commerce - is a HE Diploma and will provide 1 years credit towards any Bachelor of Business program
- AD010 Associate Degree in Business - is a HE qualification that will offer 2 years of credit into any Business program.
