



Staff Payroll Giving

By donating through RMIT staff payroll giving, you receive your tax deduction for your donation each pay, rather than having to wait until the end of the tax year. When RMIT calculates the amount of tax to be withheld from your salary for a pay period, the donation amount is deducted from your gross salary. At the end of each tax year, your PAYG payment summary will provide you with confirmation of your donations to RMIT. For more information on tax, please visit **www.ato.gov.au**.
