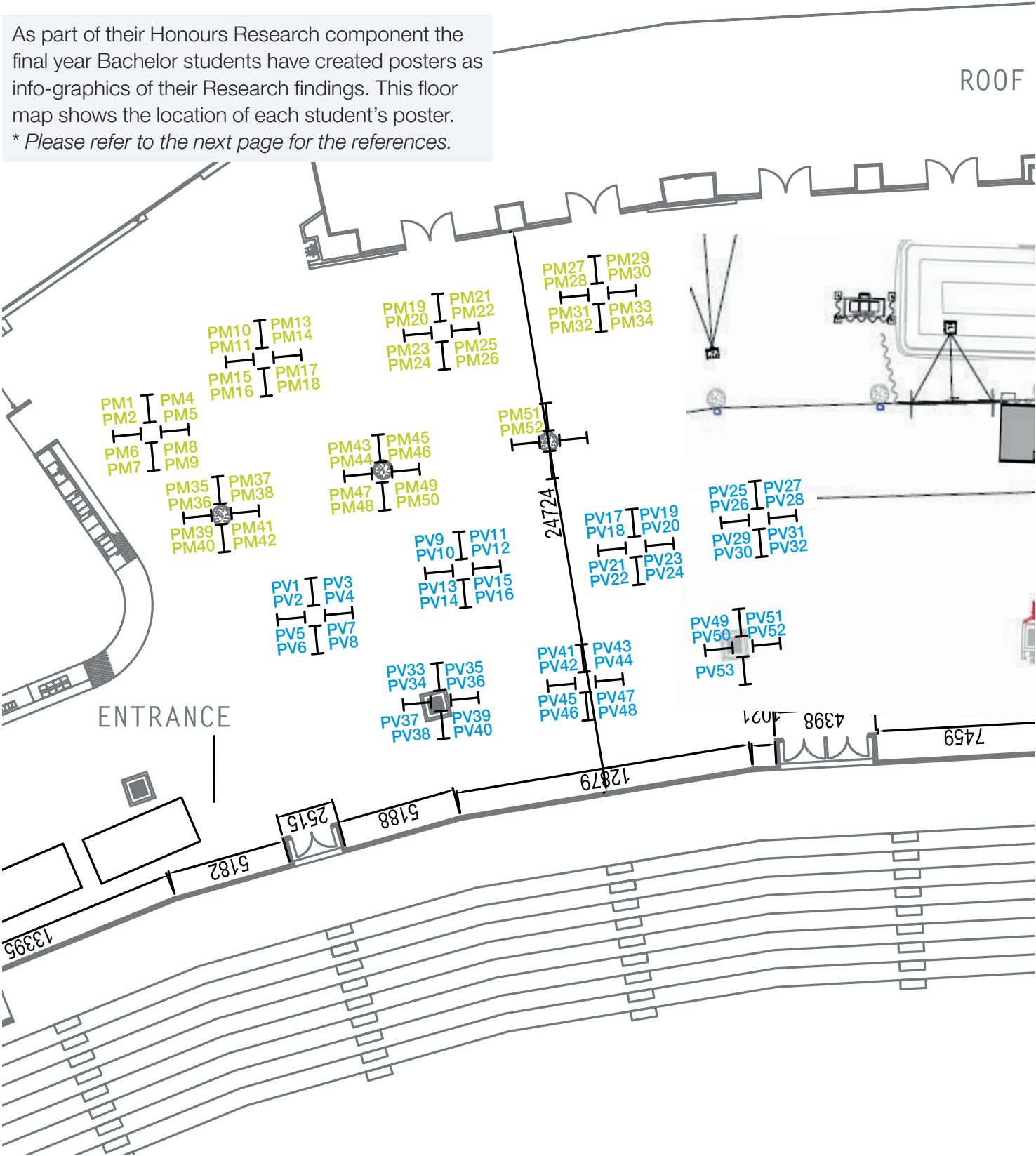

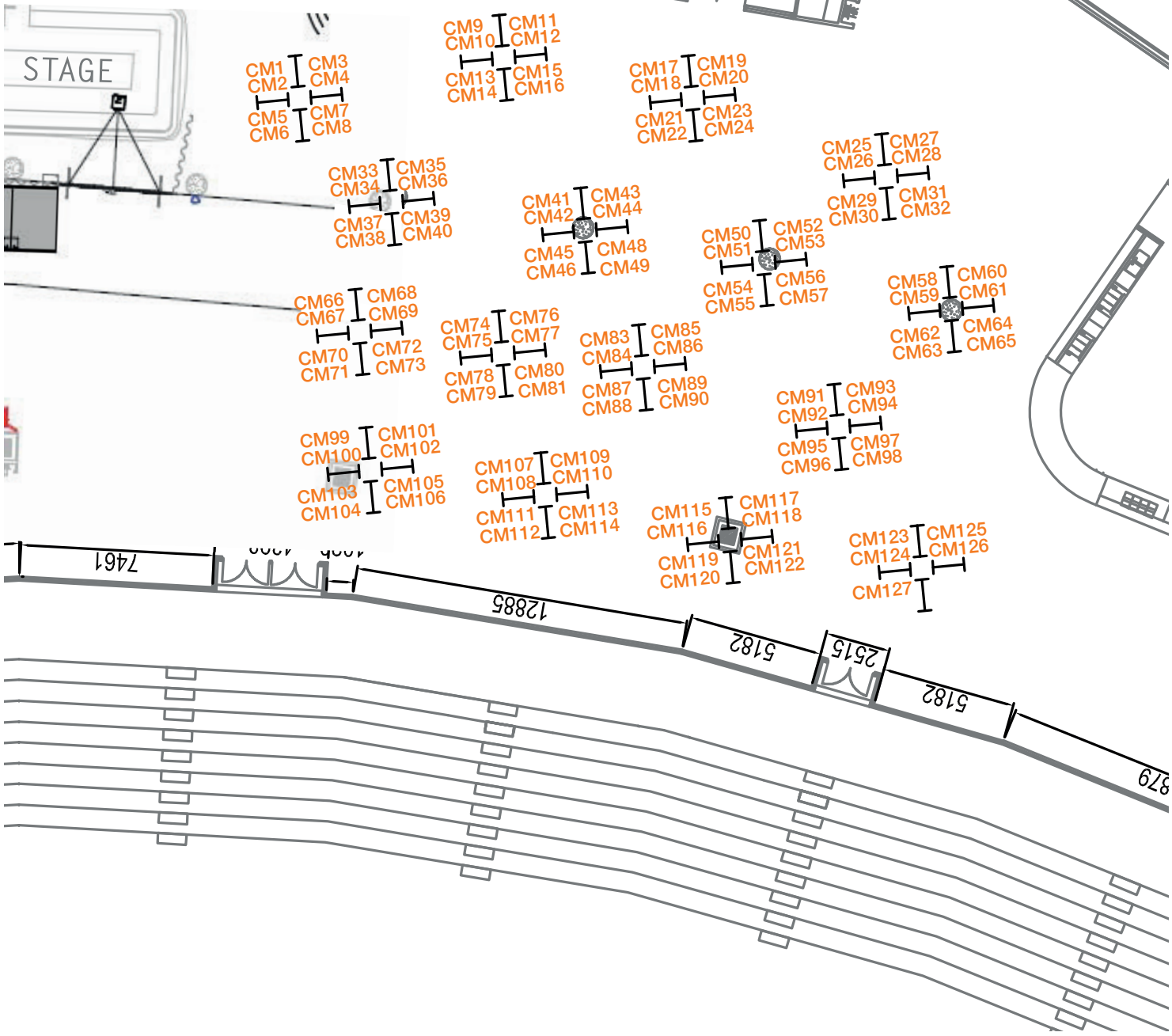
As part of their Honours Research component the final year Bachelor students have created posters as info-graphics of their Research findings. This floor map shows the location of each student's poster.
