
Job growth

Most rewarding part of teaching



Bachelor of Education (Primary Education) — Bundoora

Learn how to be a leader in primary education with this qualification.

You'll take part in elective courses, which allow you to broaden your understanding in a range of areas, including STEM education, teaching languages, indigenous studies, sustainability in schools and coaching children's sport.

Bachelor of Education (Primary and Early Childhood Education) — Bundoora

This degree gives you a deep understanding of children's developmental stages and strong knowledge of play-based learning pedagogies. You will acquire skills to design high quality curricula that meets student's development and learning needs.

Bachelor of Education (Primary Education and Disability Inclusion) — Bundoora

Develop the skills needed to teach learners with a range of abilities in dedicated schools or inclusive learning environments in mainstream primary schools. You will have the skills to create authentic learning experiences for all students.

Bachelor of Education (Primary and Physical Education and Sport) — Bundoora

This degree will prepare you for classroom teaching and/or teaching health, physical and sports education in educational settings. You will develop your knowledge, skills and capabilities to work actively with learners in the classroom and on the sporting field through a combination of theoretical knowledge, and professional experience.
