Describe a **verbal presentation** you have given to people and explain the purpose of this presentation and how you prepared for it. This presentation may have been for any occasion you wish to describe (maximum 150 words).

Outline and describe your level of ability with any **film, video or audio production equipment** you have had experience with. Please list equipment, hardware and software items and rate your ability as either: novice/beginner, competent, fairly proficient, confident, very capable, professionally experienced, professionally expert (maximum 150 words).

SECTION 5: Story board

Please **attach a story board** based on the key word **“strategy”**. Your story board should convey the meaning or an illustration of this word in a specific visual form. The form must be four images arranged together into a single sequence to convey or illustrate the word you have been given. Aim to make your sequence understandable to a wide audience.

This task is a visual thinking challenge so there must be no written text, captions, signs, thought bubbles, etc. included. It must be purely visual. The aim is to create a visual story idea that will have a recognisable logic for your audience.

This is not a test of your ability to draw. Stick figures are acceptable. This is an opportunity to show your ability to think in pictures.

Submission instructions:

- The story board should be formatted to fit on an A4 page
- Upload your story board. File must not exceed 5MB.

- Provide a URL to your storyboard if hosted online. If the URL is to a private page or folder please provide the password.
