The [Experience Surveying at Yarra Bend Park](#) days for high school students will be running again for 2018.

This practical one hour event gives students an insight into the industry of land surveying. RMIT surveying staff will guide students through a hands-on experience measuring distance using the current surveying equipment used in the industry including a digital level, total station, GPS and laser scanner.

Surveyors work on a diverse variety of projects from land subdivision and mining exploration, to tunnel building and major construction, which means no two days are the same. They are experts in determining land size and measurement. They also give advice and provide information to guide the work of engineers, architects and developers.

Our Experience Surveying events are held once a month at RMIT's Field Station at Yarra Bend and are designed for people in years 10 -12.
