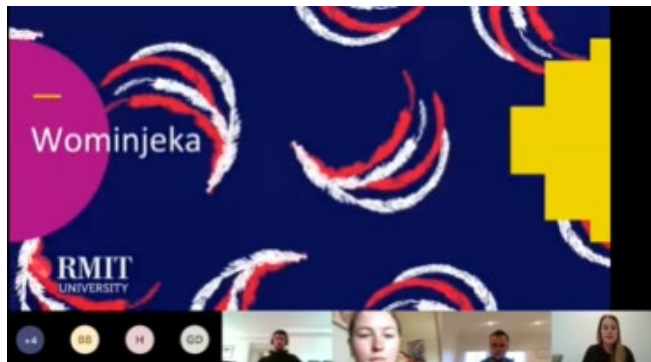

Regional pilot students up and away in Bendigo

Aspiring commercial pilots from regional Victoria are studying at RMIT's new flight training centre at Bendigo Airport.

The state-of-the-art facility has students from regional towns and cities such as Shepparton, Macedon, Woodend, Ballarat, Arthur's Creek, Gisborne and Bendigo.

Mike Heffey is the head of RMIT's Flight Training at the Bendigo and Point Cook airports.

"We've added two extra classrooms inside the hangar, so student capacity is about 50 for now," Mike said.

"Students spend one day a week in Melbourne for some lectures. Four days a week, it's 8.30am-4.30pm at the airports with more theory, navigation planning and flying."



"The Associate Degree is being fast-tracked at Bendigo because of the ample flying time students and instructors have," Mike said.

Careers advisors are welcome to visit the Bendigo base when restrictions are lifted.

"Many advisors have been out to the Bendigo hangar, and when time allows some have been up for a flight," Mike said.

"As soon as the corona fog lifts and visits are allowed we'd welcome teachers, principals and keen students to come to Bendigo meet our instructors and students."
