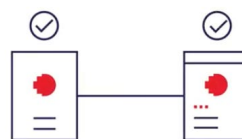
The new [Diploma of Applied Technologies](#) blends practical experience with electrical and control applications built on a strong theoretical foundation.

- All you need to know about RMIT (fortnightly)

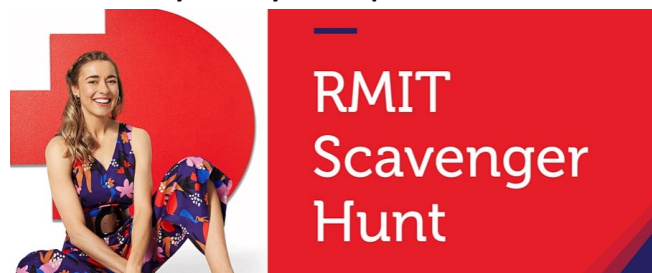
