### Associate Degree in Digital Technologies (Advanced Manufacturing)

Designed to cover emerging digital manufacturing technologies, this associate degree equips graduates with the skills and practical experience to pursue a career within Industry 4.0 technologies.

### Certificate IV in Cybersecurity

Are your students keen to get hands-on training in IT in a Free TAFE program? This certificate at RMIT will get them skilled up quickly to meet the fast-growing demand in cybersecurity.

Students will gain knowledge and practical experience in managing cybersecurity risks, mitigating threats and developing systems to minimise network vulnerabilities.

After graduating, they'll be ready for the world of work, or they can pathway into the Associate Degree in Information Technology at RMIT.

### 2021 enrolments reopened - Certificate II in Electrotechnology (Pre-Vocational)

This pre-apprenticeship is designed to give students an edge when competing for an apprenticeship in the fields of electrical, instrumentation and air conditioning/refrigeration.

The electrotechnology pre-apprenticeship provides students with an introduction to two industries: electrical and refrigeration/air-conditioning.

Taught full-time at RMIT, it mixes theory with the practical skills required across these industries.

This certificate leads to an apprenticeship as an electrician or an air-conditioning and refrigeration mechanic.

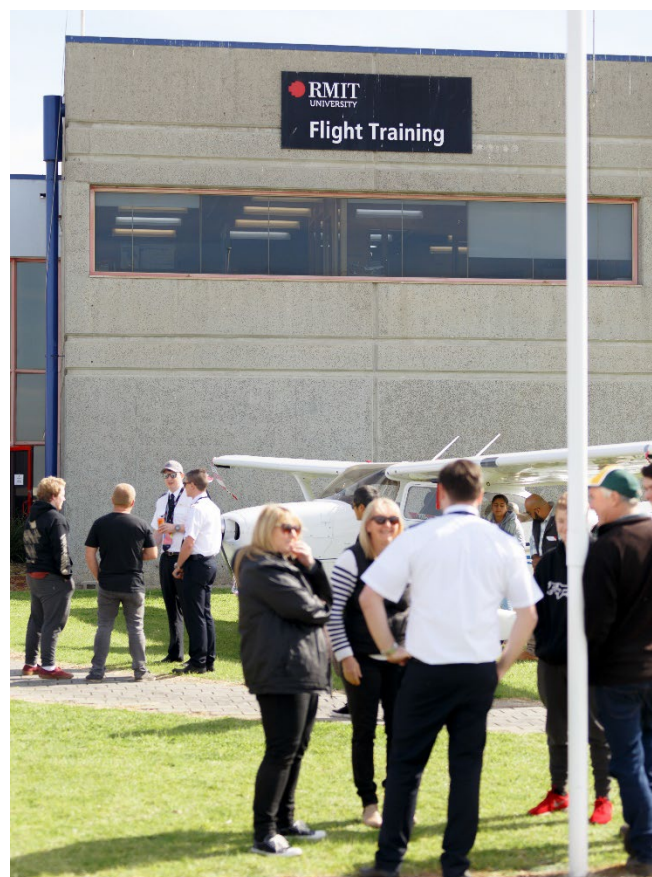
## Bendigo Flight Training visits

Parents and students are again welcome to visit RMIT's pilot training facility at the Bendigo airport.

Anyone considering studying to be a pilot can come out to the hangar at Bendigo to see our facilities and meet our instructors who will explain how the program works.

The timeslots for student and parent visits are between **3-5pm each Wednesday and Saturday throughout the school year.**



RMIT offers an [Associate Degree in Aviation \(Professional Pilots\)](#) and a [Bachelor of Applied Science \(Aviation\)](#) as Aviation qualifications

Students can study at the Bendigo facility (Associate Degree only) or at Point Cook near Melbourne where the pilot training is conducted from the Royal Australian Air Force based. Flight Training open days will also be held at Bendigo and Point Cook this year.

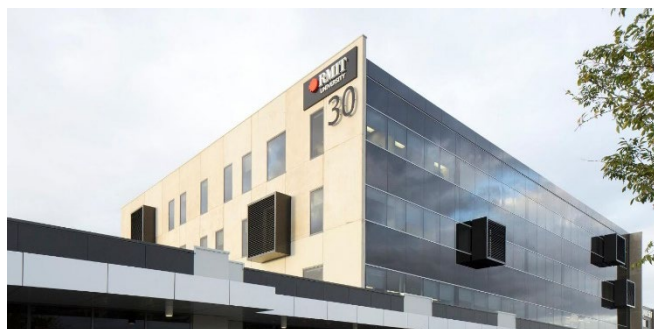
## RMIT Health Clinic Bundoora
