Your students can search for course options, join live Q&A panels and information sessions, and explore the study tours, industry placements and clubs that you can join when you become part of the RMIT community.

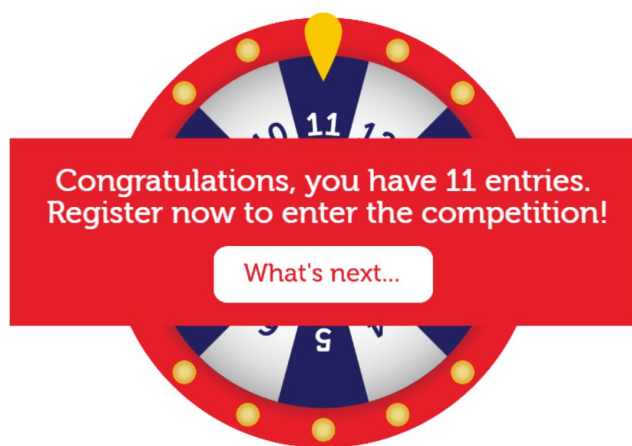

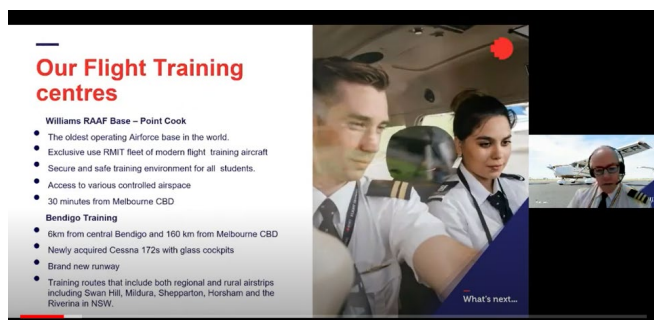
Discover What's Next Series
