Entry requirements

Academic

- An Australian bachelor degree or equivalent, or higher level qualification, in any discipline from a recognised tertiary institution with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (out of 4.0); or
- An Australian bachelor degree or equivalent, or higher level qualification, in any discipline from a recognised tertiary institution and a GMAT overall minimum score of 600; or
- The RMIT Graduate Certificate in Business Administration (Executive).

Work Experience

In addition to the academic requirements, you must provide evidence of a minimum of three years full-time equivalent work experience in a management role with supervisory responsibilities. Applicants will be required to submit a curriculum vitae (CV) that outlines supervision of staff, performance review and responsibility to budget.

Credits and exemptions

If you have successfully completed one of the following qualifications you will be eligible for exemptions:

- Graduate certificate in the same discipline
- Graduate diploma in the same discipline
- Master degree in a business-related discipline

You may also be eligible for further credits. See the program website for more detail.
