
There are lots of events happening over the next few months and plenty of opportunities for you to get involved in Sustainability initiatives.

## IT'S GETTING BREEZY @ RMIT



#### We are breezing into 2019...LITERALLY!

RMIT is committed to managing resources for the long term, which is why we are excited to share that our newly constructed wind farm in Regional Victoria will provide **25% of RMIT's electricity** this year.

Fourteen members of the Melbourne Renewable Energy
Program (MREP) combined their purchasing power to support the construction of the 39 turbines generating 80 MW at the Crowlands windfarm, near Ararat.

The wind farm is owned and operated by Melbourne based clean energy company Pacific Hydro. A great step in our transition towards a renewable future.
