The [Jean Monnet Sustainable Development Goals Network](#) is presenting a series of workshops for graduate students and early career researchers (broadly defined) aimed at making sense of the emerging place of the SDGs in universities.

In this workshop, participants will explore publication opportunities for SDG-aligned research. Using a call for chapters in the forthcoming Springer Encyclopedia of the SDGs, participants will be guided through the complex processes of academic publication, including choosing where to submit, preparing an abstract, preparing your article, how to respond to reviewer comments and how peer-review works.

This workshop is designed for ECR academics and later-stage PhD students who have yet to start publishing, or who have started publishing and would like to publish more, and more effectively.
