### Eligibility

This prize is awarded to the student in Bachelor of Business Economics and Finance who achieves the highest average mark in the following courses: ECON1042, ECON1048, ECON1061, ECON1066, ECON1082 & ECON1086

- Students who have completed and achieved academic excellence in Economic Studies.



### Selection Criteria

Awarded to the 2019 graduate who achieved academic excellence in Economic Studies.



- The prize is awarded to the graduate with the highest average across the following economics courses;  
ECON 1042 - Macroeconomics 2  
ECON 1061- Quantitative Analysis  
ECON 1048 - Price Theory  
ECON 1066 - Basic Economics  
ECON 1086 - International Trade  
ECON 1082 - International Monetary Economics



### Timeline

- Students must have completed the following economics courses - ECON 1042, ECON 1061, ECON 1048, ECON 1066, ECON 1086 and ECON 1082 to be eligible for the prize.
- The prize recipient will be notified in May 2020 and invited to attend the Prize Ceremony event to be held in May 2020.
- For monetary prizes, prize recipients will be paid into their nominated bank account before the end of June 2020.
