Eligibility

All students who successfully completed the Labour Law course in the Juris Doctor program in 2019 either face-to-face or through OUA.



Selection Criteria

The prize is awarded to the highest achieving student in Labour Law (LAW1039/OJD412), studying face-to-face or through OUA in the Juris Doctor program.

The awarding of the prize is determined jointly by Professor Anthony Forsyth and John Tuck, National Workplace Practice Group Leader, based on criteria including:

- Academic achievement across both pieces of assessment in the course (4,000 word research paper and final written examination).
- Demonstrated interest in labour law/workplace relations including through participation in class discussions and practical exercises throughout the course.
- Suitability for the internship.



Timeline

- The prize recipient will be notified in April / May and invited to attend the Prize Ceremony event to be held in May 2020.
- For monetary prizes, prize recipients will be paid into their nominated bank account before the end of June 2020.
