### Eligibility

This prize is awarded to a current student in the Bachelor of Business (Accountancy) Applied program who has completed ACCT1060, ACCT1048, ACCT1064 and ACCT1056 and has been identified as showing promise.



### Selection Criteria

- All students who are enrolled in the Applied program Bachelor of Business (Accountancy) and successfully completed the following Accounting courses in 2019.
  - ACCT1060 Management Accounting and Business
  - ACCT1048 Financial Accounting and Reporting
  - ACCT1064 Cost Analysis and Organisational Decisions
  - ACCT1056 Auditing 1
- Up to 5 students will be nominated by the Program Manager based on the following criteria:
  - Outstanding achievement and passion for Accounting
  - Contribution to classes
  - Demonstrating RMIT values of imagination, agility, courage, passion, impact and inclusion.
- The nominated students will be required to submit a 2-3 minute video log via explaining what motivates them, describe the skills and attributes they will bring to the Accounting industry, and explain why a career in Accounting is appealing to them.
- The video submissions will be reviewed by the prize sponsor, CAANZ, and the prize recipient will be determined and announced at the prize event.



### Timeline

- The nominees will be notified in May and invited to attend the Prize Ceremony event to be held in May 2020.
- For monetary prizes, prize recipients will be paid into their nominated bank account before the end of June 2020.
